Fees

Entry/Class Fees: All fees in US dollars. CDE: \$250 for all levels (EI members \$230). CT (Dressage and Cones only): \$150 for all levels (EI members \$130)

- \$5 fee per ADS competitor or \$30 fee per ADS non-member competitor.

Entry Fee Refund Policy: \$50 office fee will be deducted from all refunds. Before closing date, full refund minus office fee. After closing date up until 72 hours before event starts, full refund minus office fee only if can backfill from waiting list. No refunds after 72 hours prior to event start.

Stall Fees and Arrangements: \$90 per stall, available Friday 1 p.m. through Sunday 6 p.m. Additional nights, if approved, are \$45. One bag of shavings is included in stall fee. Marathon

Marathon will be in Controlled Warm-up format.

Terrain: Pasture, sand track, forest trails, dirt and gravel roads. Can be bumpy in places. Not many hills. Wildlife may be encountered.

Training: all turnouts Section B: 4-6 km total; 5 obstacles, each with 3 gates **Preliminary:** all turnouts Section B: 5-7 km total; 6 obstacles, each with 4 gates **Intermediate:** all turnouts Section B: 5-7 km total; 6 obstacles, each with 5 gates

Other: Water obstacle(s) for all divisions. Mandatory safety check 15 minutes before your Marathon go.

<u>Cones</u>

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Grass /Grass

Training, Preliminary, Intermediate: Minimum clearances by class and vehicle width per Article 973.1.7 **Advanced/Intermediate Hybrid:** standard clearances per FEI rules.

Other: No bridges or water crossings for Cones. Planned opening for course inspection by 6 p.m. Friday. Reminder that helmets are required in Cones per ADS rules.

Other Information

Medical Armbands or equivalent such as Road ID are encouraged for all persons on a carriage at any time during the event.

Veterinary / Equine Health Requirements:

To promote health and welfare of all horses, Equestrians Institute complies with ADS and State rules regarding horse welfare, including but not limited to:

- Proof of vaccination or veterinary exemption for Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus current within six months prior to the opening of the event. See ADS Art. 6.3.
- All out-of-state equines require negative Coggins current within six months prior to the opening of the event. Vet health certificate required for horses coming into Washington State. Please check with your vet for particulars, as state requirements have changed.
- Biosecurity measures are followed at all EI events. For more info: https://www.usef.org/search?q=biosecurity

Driver/Groom more than once around allowed on marathon? Competitors and navigators may compete more than once **ONLY IF schedule permits**. Sharing of carriages, navigators, more than once around – subject to advance scheduling only as listed on driver's entry. Request must be included with driver's entry to be considered.

VSE/Pony Measurement: All ponies and VSEs must be officially measured per ADS rules and must compete in their designated divisions. Please submit a file copy of your official ADS measurement card with your entry. See ADS webpage for more details.

Para Drivers and drivers needing dispensation for disabilities, please contact the ADS to secure your certificate. This certificate must be included with your entry.

Awards Offered: Ribbons through fifth place. Special merit awards and special breed awards. Classes may be combined for awards.

Misc. Show info:

- No lunging in camping/parking area.
- Stalls and camping/parking spots to be assigned. Must include total length of rig on entry from (truck/RV plus trailer length). Please list preferences on entry form and we will do our best to accommodate.
- No human shower facilities on site. Horse and carriage washing by bucket only to conserve water.
- Dogs must be on leash and under control at all times.
- Limited number of **golf carts** available for rental, first come, first served. \$190 for a cart that seats two; \$275 for a cart that seats four. Separate check not required.

Food Available on the Grounds: Yes. Concessions for breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday.

Accommodations: Many motels are available in the nearby area.

Camping on Grounds: Yes, no hook-ups. Electrical hookup for medical needs only and must be arranged in advance with organizer.

Directions:

Rainbow Meadow Farm is located at 4711 176th Ave SW, Rochester, WA. Use this address if you are assigned parking by the permanent barns. If you are assigned to park and stable in the portable stalls stabling area (called show stabling below), use 17743 Leitner Rd SW, Rochester, WA in your GPS to get to the correct facility entrance. Here are directions in case you need them:

- If you are coming from I-5 take exit 88. Turn east onto Old Highway 99 SE which is a right turn if you exit from northbound I-5 and a left turn if you exit from southbound I5.
- In 2.5 miles, turn left onto 183rd Ave SW
- In .1 mile turn right onto Danby Rd SW
- In .9 miles Danby Rd turns 90 degrees and becomes Leitner Rd SW.
- If you are assigned parking in the **show stabling area**, the entrance is 300 feet and on the left just before the start of the white fence.
- If you are assigned **parking by the permanent barns** (daily haul-ins and medical needs) in .3 miles Leitner Rd SW turns into 176th Ave SE. Follow the white fence around the corner and turn left at the yellow barn with the big rainbow.
